



Student scholarships are a driving force behind the University of Haifa's success. They represent a key investment in the academic future of Israel and in meeting the social, cultural and technological challenges that lie ahead.

As Israel's most pluralistic academic institution, the University of Haifa is committed to closing the social, educational and economic gaps that exist within Israeli society. Since its founding more than 40 years ago, the University has been dedicated to making the goal of higher education accessible to all.

BRIGHT AND NEEDY STUDENTS

In keeping with its commitment to providing education to the best and brightest, the University of Haifa is opening doors for students from low-income families, by providing financial aid for those who need it most.

Our diverse scholarship programs and pioneering academic and leadership projects for students of different ethnic, religious and socio-economic backgrounds have become successful models for empowerment and promoting equal opportunities.

SOLDIERS

The Scholarship Fund for Soldiers shows appreciation to the young men and women who have served the State of Israel, providing security to citizens and tourist alike. Recipients are selected according to the University of Haifa's scholarship criteria.

Priority is given to combat and combat-support soldiers and particularly those who live in Israel's peripheral areas, are from low-income families and/or disadvantaged socio-economic backgrounds. Recipients are required to maintain satisfactory academic progress.

MINORITY STUDENTS

While academic scholarships provide a necessary foundation for minority populations to participate in higher level education, scholarships alone are insufficient to ensure academic and professional success.

Once they begin their studies, minority students require a more holistic support system to thrive and excel. Many are the first generation in their family to pursue higher education degrees. They often need support to secure housing in the campus dormitories, and additional scholarship support to pay for text books and food services at the University.



ADVANCED STUDIES

The President's Scholarships for Success Program, a fellowship program for doctoral students, provides academic scholarship support and living expenses over a four year period. The current cohort of more than 1,000 doctoral candidates – among them, tomorrow's faculty luminaries – engages in cutting-edge research while mentoring new generations of students.

Doctoral scholarships are a particularly critical element in the University's strategic vision for the future of Israeli academic leadership. A strong doctoral scholarship program will make it possible for the University of Haifa to help reverse the "brain drain" of gifted scientists and thinkers from leaving Israeli institutions of higher learning in order to pursue doctoral and post-graduate studies abroad, and build careers outside of Israel.

THE IMPACT OF COVID-19

Students at the University of Haifa have been able to continue their education through online lectures and other coursework, and our faculty are contributing expertise and knowledge on a global scale in critical fields.

Our role as a catalyst for social and economic development, particularly in the north of Israel, will ensure the city of Haifa's return to stability and increase prosperity and security for the region.

While we are committed to this future, we are cognizant of the immediate needs our community is facing during this time of great uncertainty.

Many students have lost their part-time jobs as a result of this crisis, and their parents are struggling to make ends meet. To help those students who are in desperate need of financial support, the University of Haifa has established a "Student Solidarity Fund".



Scholarship gifts may be earmarked to include tuition fees, educational tools (books, laptops, and photocopying), living stipends, meal vouchers, educational support and counselling and research expenses.

Many of our students are the first in their families to attend university. In addition to alleviating the cost of tuition, stipends for living expenses enable students to worry less about finances and focus on their learning and completing their degree on time. Endowed support for our students is a fundamental investment for the future of the University.
